What have we been learning this week?

Welcome back to school. I hope you all had a restful break. Nursery have settled quickly back into the normal routine. This week we have begun learning about our new topic for this half term: Underwater. Part of learning about Under the Water has been to think about places we might find water. The children went on a water hunt around the school and found different places we could access water. We also thought about the different ways water can be used.

During carpet time we have been clapping and jumping amounts to 5 and discovering how to represent these amounts with our fingers and objects.
