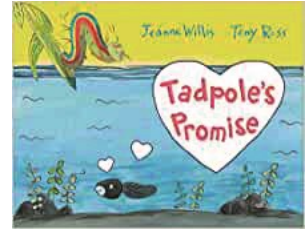

What have we been learning this week?

We have been enjoying reading and retelling the story 'Tadpoles promise'. We have been remembering the events of the story and learning to sequence what happens at the beginning, middle and end of the story.



In our knowledge and understanding of the world lessons we have continued to look at under the sea. This week the children made starfish using salt dough. They had to remember the features of the starfish as they were making it.



How can you help your child with their learning?

Practise your hand-eye coordination at home or in the park with a small ball or alternatively roll up a sock to catch and throw.

In maths we have been learning about amounts to 5; recognising, counting and showing the number on our fingers. Can you clap 4 or 5 or do 3 jumps or stomps? Learning to stop counting at a given number is an important skill. Can you also count out four from a larger amount e.g. pens, cutlery for dinner or toys?
