What have we been learning this week?

English

We have been enjoying reading and retelling the story of "The Tiny Seed". We have been remembering the events of the story and learning to sequence what happens at the beginning, middle and end of the story. The tiny seed travels on a long journey through the seasons. Using our knowledge of how the seasons change helped us to understand the changes which happen to the tiny seed. We are in the season of Spring.



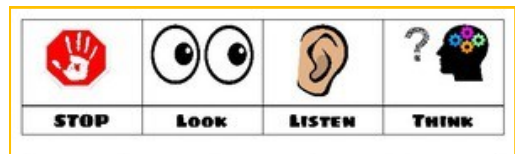
Maths: Composition of 10

Our maths focus this week has been all about 10. We have used rhymes, tens frames and different objects to recognise ways of making 10. The children are confident in describing the number facts they have found, using number sentences. For example, $4 + 6 = 10$.



Knowledge and Understanding of the world: Keeping Safe

We have been learning about Road Safety. Reception have learned the importance of holding hands when crossing the road and when it is safe to cross. We used role play to practise crossing safely, using new vocabulary related to road safety.



How can you help your child with their learning?

10 add zero you're a superhero!

9 add 1, wiggle your thumb

8 add 2, tap your shoe

7 add 3, look at the tree

6 add 4, knock on the door

5 add 5, yay I'm alive

4 add 6, pick up those sticks

3 add 7, point to heaven

2 add 8, high five a mate

1 add 9, stars that shine

And zero add 10, pick up that pen!

Use this number rhyme to help remember pairs of numbers that make 10.
