What have we been learning this week?

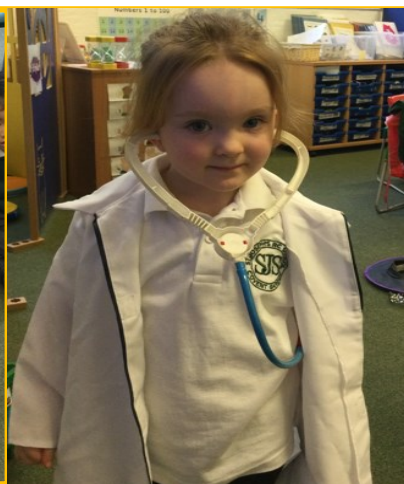
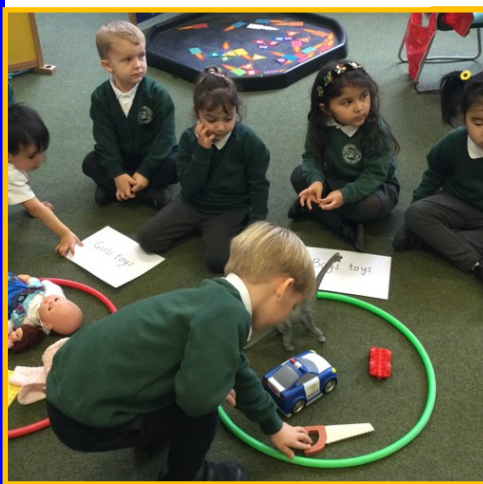
We have been learning about Bonfire night and the different ways we can celebrate Bonfire night.

The children used different materials to create their firework art work and investigated what happens when we mix different colours together. In maths we have been using 2D shapes to create pictures and have practised naming some of the shapes we have used. Our focus this week has been circles and triangles.



Knowledge and Understanding of the World: Equality studies

This week the children have started to understand the importance of being fair. Nursey were given a box of toys to sort using two labels 'toys for boys' and 'toys for girls'. As the children were sorting, they found they played with the same toys. They decided that it wasn't fair to label toys and decided that 'toys should be for everyone'.
