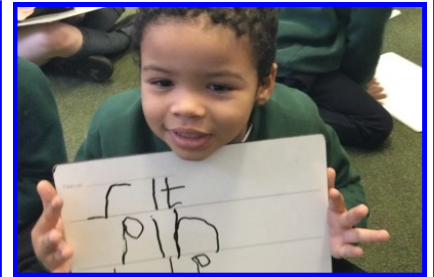
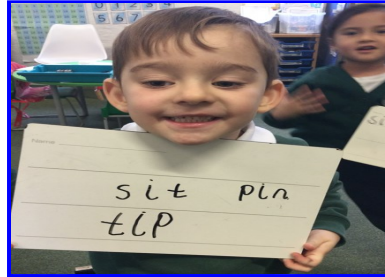

What have we been learning this week?

Phonics

The focus this week has been on reviewing our set 1 digraphs and writing 3 letter words. We reviewed the sounds 'i' and 'n' and the children wrote words with these sounds in. For example: Sit and Pin.



Maths: Representing numbers to 3

This week the children have been representing 1, 2 and 3 in lots of different ways. Using objects, pictures and drawings, the children took part in a range of activities that relied upon them recording amounts to 3.



Knowledge and Understanding of the World

In RE we have begun to learn about Baptism and the signs and symbols associated with this sacrament. We re-enacted a Baptism in the classroom so that we could see what happens on this special occasion.

The children also planned a birthday party for our class teddy bear. Using their learning about how we celebrate birthdays, they wrote invitations, decorated the classroom and made cupcakes. We also played party games and danced to music too.



How can you help your child with their learning?

Puzzles are a great activity for problem solving. Also giving your child problems to figure out themselves such as, 'Your favourite hat is missing, what shall we do?' This will help your child to think independently and come up with ways to help themselves.
