What have we been learning this week?

How can you help your child with their learning?

- Sort objects according to size, can you find small shoes, medium size shoes and large shoes at home or other objects such as coats, hats or socks? Play alongside your child and talk about different words for size for example tiny, small, bigger, enormous, massive.
- Listen to the story at home,. There is a link on the BBC radio teach website which has listening and attention activities, join in with the Goldilocks song as well as we have been singing it in class
- Make porridge at home with your child, what happens when you add the milk/ water and talk about how the microwave works (with supervision).
