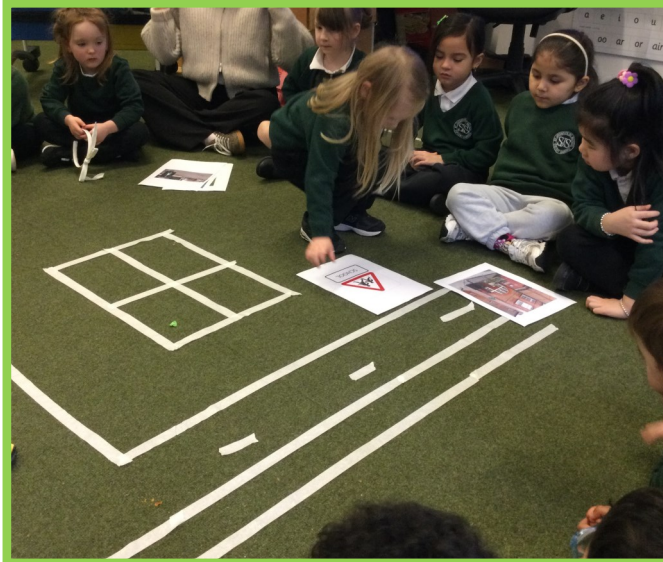

### What have we been learning this week?

This week the children have been learning how to keep safe when crossing the road. Using our new rhyme 'Stop, Look, Listen and Think', the children practised crossing our pretend road at the right places. They also had to think about what to do if there was a green light for pedestrians but we could hear a very fast ambulance approaching.



### How can you help your child with their learning?

Practise your hand-eye coordination at home or in the park with a small ball or alternatively roll up a sock to catch and throw.

In maths we have been learning about amounts to 5; recognising, counting and showing the number on our fingers. Can you clap 4 or 5 or do 3 jumps or stomps? Learning to stop counting at a given number is an important skill. Can you also count out four from a larger amount e.g. pens, cutlery for dinner or toys?



We're going to the Moon.


