What have we been learning this week?

This week we have been reading the story of 'Jack and the beanstalk'. We enjoyed listening to the story and then retelling it with our friends using story language, character puppets and masks to act out the story.



Knowledge and Understanding of the world: Seasons

This week we have continued looking at our topic "Growing". We learnt about the different parts of a plant and what their purposes are. We also learnt a song to help us remember the key parts of a plant; The roots, stem, leaves and flower. We are learning about what a plant needs to stay healthy and grow. Then we continued with planting our own strawberry and carrot seeds!



How can you help your child with their learning?

Please make sure you read with your child every day. Reading for 10-15 minutes, is one of the most important things you can do to help your child learn.

We are learning about rhythm in phonics by clapping syllables in words such as your child's name or objects. For example, 'strawberry' has 3 claps or syllables. See if you can do this at home. This video is for adults to watch for more information.
