What have we been learning this week?

This week we have been learning all about the life cycle of a plant. We read the story 'The Tiny Seed' to remind us of how a plant starts as a seed and the stages involved for the plant to grow.



In maths we have been finding different ways of showing amounts up to 5. We have used our fingers, counting objects, drawings and numicon to help us make 5.

Knowledge and Understanding of the world: Growing vegetables

We have been learning all about vegetables in our topic learning this week. We explored and named different vegetables, looking at how some are similar and how some are different. We then discussed what vegetables we liked and we made our own salads! We made sure to wash our hands before touching the vegetables and used our cooking utensils safely.



How can you help your child with their learning?

In phonics we continue to learn about environmental sounds. At home collect different objects around the house that make different sounds for example; a set of keys, crisp packet, squeaky toy. Put them in a box and have your child match the sound to the object.
